GET AN OVERVIEW OF THE CURRENT STATUS OF EPR FOR TEXTILES IN DENMARK

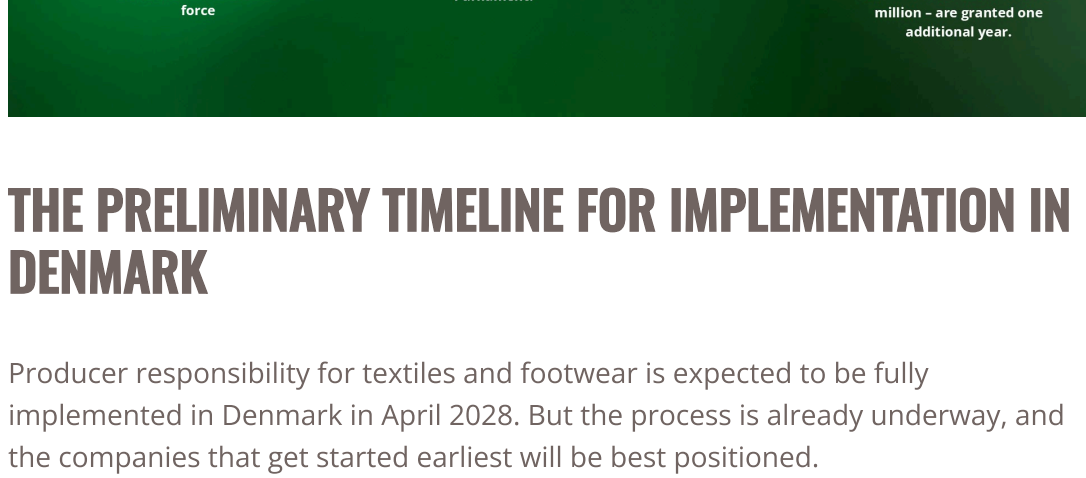
At least 4,000 Danish companies will face a new legal requirement within the next few years.

But the rules are not yet in place, and many key questions remain unanswered – from which products are covered, to what it will cost.

This makes it difficult to prepare, which is precisely why it is important to stay informed now.

We have gathered what we know – and what we don't yet know – about the implementation of producer responsibility in Denmark.

THE PRELIMINARY TIMELINE FOR IMPLEMENTATION IN DENMARK

Producer responsibility for textiles and footwear is expected to be fully implemented in Denmark in April 2028. But the process is already underway, and the companies that get started earliest will be best positioned.

The most important thing to prepare for as a company is being able to report your volumes – i.e. how much you have placed on the Danish market.

If the process resembles that of packaging, you will be required to submit an **estimate of your expected volumes for 2027 by mid-2027**. This means you need to start mapping your products and volumes now.

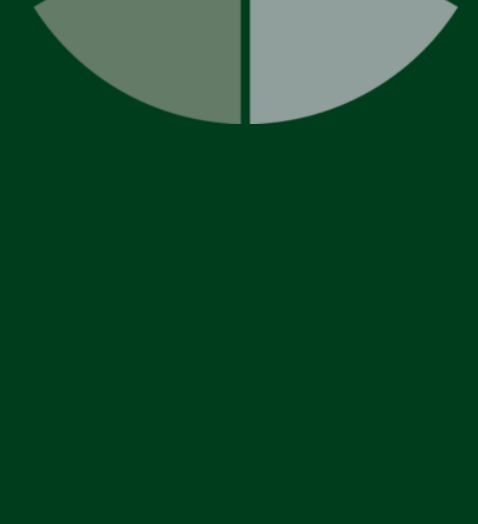

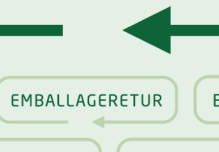
